## MerMagic Con Announcement Regarding COVID-19

(MANASSAS, Va, August 15, 2021) – Providing a convention while prioritizing safety and protecting attendees and staff from risks connected to COVID-19 is no small feat. Minimizing the risks connected to COVID-19 required the participation of all attendees and staff, and we appreciate each and every one of you who did your part to keep yourself and the community safe. We are proud to report that of MerMagic Con's 400+ attendees, over 90% provided proof of being fully vaccinated and many fully-vaccinated attendees continued to wear masks whenever possible.

MerMagic Con staff followed strict protocols before, during, and after convention hours—every staff member was fully vaccinated prior to the start of MerMagic Con.

On August 15th, 2021 MerMagic Con staff received a report of an attendee having testing positive for COVID-19 sometime after having attended the convention. It is unknown as to whether this attendee acquired COVID-19 at the convention. Regardless, we encourage everyone to get a COVID-19 test to protect the community and help stop the spread.
